WHAT WILL I STUDY?

Students will study 4 compulsory units:

- **Unit 1:** Building Positive Relationships (60 credits)
- **Unit 2:** Equality, diversity and rights (60 credits)
- **Unit 3:** Health and Safety (60 credits)
- **Unit 4:** Anatomy and Physiology (90 credits)

In addition students will complete 2 optional units; this year's cohort have completed:

- Public Health (30 credits)
- Sexual health, reproduction and early development stages (60 credits)

HOW WILL I BE ASSESSED?

The course comprises of both examined and coursework based units.

Unit 1, plus the optional units, form the students portfolio that will be built over the two years.

Units 2-4 are examined units that comprise of short answers and extended writing.
