- Establish the merits and drawbacks of different options for individuals and providers.
- Fully explain how and why things happen and what the impact is.
- Provide a balanced argument with clear links to legislation and codes of practice.
- Demonstrate empathy and understanding.

WHEN STUDENTS OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL STUDIES THINK THEY:

- Aim to solve problems.
- Understand the needs of individuals.
- Consider why individuals, providers and government act in the ways they do.
- Consider the merits and drawbacks of different solutions.
